The classical legend

- Vessel at the last supper.
- 2 Captured blood after crucification.
- Magic properties: health, everlasting life ...
- Lost since medieval times (at least).

- One of the earliest apostles.
- Obtained grail from Joseph of Arimathea.
- \bigcirc Went to Aragon around 40 AD. \rightarrow El Pilar.
- Return to holy land, martyrdom, beheaded under Herodes Agrippa

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- Found in Toledo



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Description

Heathen, astronomer, descendant of Salomo ...

Explanation

- Abu Jafar Muhammad ibn al-Hasan Al-Khazin (~ 900-971)
- Discusses Ptolemy, Egyptian mathematics.
- Known for Zij al-Safa'ih (Tables of the disks of the astrolabe).
- Lat. flexus = "arc. curve".
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Next Stop: Jaca



Where is the grail?

Search in Aragon

- 🕕 Monastry San Juan de la Peña.
- Oclose to old king's town Jaca last stronghold before reconquista.
- Important position on the Camino Aragones. Tour from Troves.
- Region known as "Mont Salvage" (in Occitaine).
- But: no castle, does not fit Wolfram's description.
- "Gralsburg": Loarre (Huesca).

Logical consequence

- Store holy object in monastry.
- Mights of the holy grail in relative neighborhood.



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

Arab conquests and reconquista

- Arab conquest of Spain ~ 700 (Visigoths before).
- Reconquest beginning with Galicia.
- Battle of Clavijo (844). Victory attributed to Santiago.
- Northwest relatively unimportant.
- Second period: 1085-1212, Aragon became "war zone".

- Still "first hand" experience for Chretien.
- Copy in Jaca (now in Valencia).

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Amsterdam 1788: Construction of the *Alliantie*

- Frigate with 36 cannons
- Siege of Acre in 1799
- Vanishes in 1802: "sold".

Paris 1789: French revolution.

Paris 1788: *Lagrange's* mechanics.

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Acre/Akkon

- Most important harbour of Holy Land, old name Ptolemais.
- ② Important for crusaders and templars.
- Stronghold built by "Deutscher Orden".
- 4 Administration by Ordo Hospitalis sancti Johannis Ierosolimitani.

- Part of Napoleon's expedition to Egypt.
- Bonaparte: ... who conquers Acre conquers the world.
- Egypt expedition:
 - "collected" a lot of historical documents.

Obvious timeline

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- ② Everyone becomes member in Edinburgh.
- \bigcirc \Rightarrow Discovery between 1815 and 1820.

- Look in Edinburgh.
- Look close: Rosslyn chapel.
- Also mentioned by Dan Brown, see [Lincoln, Baigent, Lee].
